SECTION 3

Constitution & Administration

Nomenclature and Constitution

1. (A) This Competition shall be designated the Upper Thames Valley League and Cup Competition and shall consist of not more than fifty-six (56) Clubs who shall be Full Member Clubs.

All new Clubs shall serve a probationary period of at least one (1) season as an Associated Member, without voting rights, before being eligible to become a Full Member.

The Management Committee shall have powers to consider and accept sponsorship of the Competitions after consultations with the Clubs.

All such Member Clubs shall be affiliated to an affiliated County Football Association and their names and particulars shall be returned annually by the appointed date on the Form "D" to the Berks & Bucks County Football Association. The area covered by the Competition Membership shall be to Clubs whose headquarters or ground are within the area bounded by a 25 mile radius from the crossroad of the A415 and the A338 at Frilford Heath.

This Competition shall apply annually for sanction to the Berks & Bucks Football Association and the constituent Teams of Member Clubs may be grouped in Divisions, each not exceeding fourteen (14) in number.

Member Clubs shall not enter any of their Teams playing in the Competition in any other Competitions (with the exception of FA and County FA Competitions) except with the written consent of the Management Committee of the Competition.

Entry Fee, Subscription, Deposit

2. (A) Applications by Clubs for admission to this Competition or the entry of an additional Team(s) shall be made in writing to the Secretary by 1st May and shall be accompanied by an Entry Fee of £20.00 per Team, which shall be returned in the event of non-election.

At the discretion of a majority of the accredited voting members present applications, of which due notice has been given, may be received at the Annual General Meeting or a Special General Meeting. The Entry Fee shall apply.

When Rule 12(B) is applied and a Team seeks a transfer or is compulsorily transferred to another Division no Entry Fee shall be payable.

(B) The Annual Subscription shall be £30.00 per Team payable on or before the 31st May in each year. Clubs failing to comply shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £20.00.

(C) Each Club shall within fourteen (14) days of election pay a Deposit of £100.00, which shall be returnable to Clubs on leaving the Competition provided they have fulfilled their fixtures and complied with all orders of the Management Committee.

(D) A Club shall not participate in this Competition until the Entry Fee, Annual Subscription and Deposit have been paid.

(E) Clubs shall advise annually to the Secretary in writing by 1st July of its County Football Association affiliation number for the forthcoming Season, failing which they shall be fined a sum not exceeding £20.00. Clubs shall advise the Secretary in writing, or on the prescribed form, of details of its Headquarters, Officers and any other information required by the Competition.

Officers

3. The Officers of the Competition shall be the President, Life Vice-Presidents, Vice-Presidents, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Treasurer, General Secretary, Assistant General Secretary, Registration Secretary, Referees Secretary, Fixture Secretary, Disciplinary Secretary and Ground & Facilities Officer, to be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting.

(N.B. Auditors are not Officers).

Management, Nomination, Election

4. (A) The Competition shall be governed in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of The Football Association by a Management Committee comprised of the Officers, eight (8) League Representatives and a Press Officer who shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting.

(B) Retiring Officers shall be eligible to become candidates for re-election without nomination. All other candidates for election as Officers or Members of the Management Committee shall be nominated to the Secretary in writing, signed by the Secretaries of two (2) Member Clubs, not later than 1st May in each year. Names of the candidates for election shall be circulated with the notice of the Annual General Meeting. In the event of there being no nomination in accordance with the foregoing for any office, nominations may be received at the Annual General Meeting

(C) The Management Committee shall meet as often as necessary to deal with business as it arises.

On receiving a requisition signed by two-thirds of the Members of the Management Committee the Secretary shall convene a meeting of the Committee.

(D) Except where otherwise mentioned all communications shall be addressed to the Secretary who shall conduct the correspondence of the Competition and keep a record of its proceedings.

(E) All communications received from Clubs shall be conducted through their nominated Officers.

Powers of Management

5. (A) The Management Committee may appoint such other Sub-Committees as they may consider necessary and may delegate such of their powers as they deem necessary to such Committees. The decisions of all such Committees shall be reported to the Management Committee for ratification.

(B) Subject to the permission of the Berks & Bucks County Football Association having been obtained the Management Committee may order a match or matches to be played each season, the proceeds to be devoted to the funds of the Competition and, if necessary, may call upon each Club (including any Club which may have withdrawn during the season) to contribute equally such sums as may be necessary to meet any deficiency at the end of the season. (See Rule 6(E)).

(C) Each Member of the Management Committee shall have the right to attend and vote at all Management Committee Meetings and have one (1) vote thereat, but no Member shall be allowed to vote on any matters directly appertaining to such Member or to the Club so represented. (This shall apply to the procedure of any Sub-Committee).

In the event of the voting being equal on any matter, the Chairman shall have a second or casting vote.

(D) The Management Committee shall have powers to apply, act upon and enforce the Rules of the Competition and shall also have jurisdiction over all matters affecting the Competition, including any not provided for in the Rules. Except where these Rules provide for the imposition of a set penalty, any Club, Official or Player alleged to be in breach of a Competition Rule shall be formally charged in writing and given the opportunity to present their case before the Management Committee. All breaches of the Laws of the Game, Rules and Regulations of The Football Association shall be dealt with in accordance with FA Rules.

(E) All decisions of the Management Committee shall be binding subject to the right of appeal to the Board of Appeal in accordance with Rule 16.

The Disciplinary Committee of this Competition shall meet monthly during the season. If a Club appears on the Disciplinary Committee monthly Agenda and Rules have been proven to be broken, then that Club for that month shall pay a cost not exceeding £50.00.

If the Management Committee is dissatisfied with the manner in which a Member Club is conducting its affairs, it shall have powers to call Officers of that Club before the Management Committee, to seek explanations and to give necessary guidance. Any Club failing to comply with a directive shall be fined a sum not exceeding £50.00.

The Management Committee before the start of the season shall supply a form, of which all member Clubs shall complete. This form shall give all information the Management Committee requires about a Club. If after submitting this form to the Management Committee, a Club wishing to alter any of that information given on that form, shall obtain the Management Committees permission.

Every Club shall be held responsible for ensuring that all Rules are complied with. For a breach of this Rule, a Club shall be fined a sum not exceeding £50.00 and ordered to pay any extra cost incurred by the Management Committee. If, after a Club has been called upon to explain the manner in which its affairs are being run, the Management Committee is still dissatisfied or if, in the Management Committees opinion subsequent events make such a course desirable, the Management Committee, which shall not delegate this power, may suspend the Club from all Competitions, and may recommend to the Annual General Meeting to exclude the Club from the Competition and to refuse any application to enter this Competition. A suspended Club may also be dealt with as if it has withdrawn under Rule 14 and the Team records dealt with accordingly.

Decisions of the Management Committee shall be notified in writing to those concerned within fourteen (14) days.

(F) Five (5) members of the Management Committee shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business of the Management Committee and three (3) members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business by any Sub-Committee of the Competition.

If any member of the Management Committee shall be absent from three consecutive meetings of the Management Committee without good reason, he shall be removed from the Management Committee. Exception to this Rule shall be the President, Life Vice-Presidents and Vice-Presidents.

(G) The Management Committee, as it may deem necessary, shall have power to fill in an acting capacity, any vacancies that may occur amongst their number.

(H) A Club having failed to comply with an order or instruction of the Management Committee, or failing to satisfactorily attend to the business and/or the correspondence of the Competition within ten (10) days of date of the letter, shall be liable to be fined a sum not exceeding £50.00 or otherwise penalised at the discretion of the Management Committee.

(I) All fines and charges shall be paid to the Disciplinary Secretary within fourteen (14) days of the date of posting of the written notification. Clubs, Officials or Individuals committing a breach of this rule shall be issued with a suspension notification by the Disciplinary Secretary, together with a fine not exceeding £50 and incur such penalties as the Management Committee may impose. If a Club fails to pay the fines imposed at least 48 hours before the date of the notified suspension, the Club shall be suspended from all competitions by the League until the matter has been settled and incurring costs of any unfulfilled games whilst under suspension.

(J) A member of the Management Committee appointed by the Competition to attend a meeting or match may have any expenses of up to 25p per mile refunded by the Competition.

The General Secretary may receive an Honorarium, the amount of which shall be agreed annually at the Annual General Meeting.

(K) The Management Committee shall have the power to fill any vacancy that may occur in the membership of the Competition. Between the Annual General or Special General Meeting called to decide the constitution and the commencement of the Competition season.

Annual General Meeting

6. (A) The Annual General Meeting shall be held not later than 30th June in each year. At this meeting the following business shall be transacted provided that at least 50% Members are present and entitled to vote:-
 - (i) To receive and confirm the Minutes of the preceding Annual General Meeting.
 - (ii) To consider any business arising therefrom.
 - (iii) To receive and adopt the Annual Report, Balance Sheet and Statement of Accounts.
 - (iv) Election of Clubs to fill vacancies (as recommended by the Management Committee).
 - (v) Constitution of the Competition for ensuing season.
 - (vi) Election of Officers and Management Committee.
 - (vii) Appointment of Auditors.
 - (viii) Alteration of Rules, if any (of which notice has been given).
 - (ix) For the commencement and conclusion Fix the date of playing season.

(x) Other business of which due notice shall have been given and accepted as being relevant to an Annual General Meeting.

(B) A copy of the duly audited Balance Sheet, Statement of Accounts and Agenda shall be forwarded to each Club at least fourteen (14) days prior to the meeting, and to the Berks & Bucks County Football Association.

(C) A signed copy of the duly audited Balance Sheet and Statement of Accounts shall be sent to the Berks & Bucks County Football Association within fourteen (14) days of its adoption by the Annual General Meeting.

(D) Each Full Member Club shall be empowered to send two (2) delegates to an Annual General Meeting. Each Club shall be entitled to one vote only. Not less than fourteen (14) days' notice shall be given of any Meeting.

(E) Clubs who have withdrawn their Membership of the Competition during the season being concluded or who are not continuing Membership shall be entitled to attend but shall vote only on matters relating to the season being concluded.

(F) All voting shall be conducted by a show of voting cards unless a ballot is demanded by at least 50% of the delegates qualified to vote or the Chairman so decides.

(G) No individual shall be entitled to vote on behalf of more than one Full Member Club.

(H) Any continuing Member Club failing to be represented at the Annual General Meeting without satisfactory reason being given shall be fined a sum not exceeding £50.00.

(I) Officers and Management Committee members shall be entitled to attend and vote at an Annual General Meeting.

Agreement to be Signed

7. The Chairman and the Secretary of each Club shall complete and sign the following agreement which shall be deposited with the Competition together with the Application for Membership for the coming season, or upon indicating that the Club intends to compete.

"We, A, _____ of _____ (Chairman) and B _____ of _____ (Secretary) of the _____ Football Club have been provided with a copy of the Rules and Regulations of the Upper Thames Valley League and Cup Competition and do hereby agree for and on behalf of the said Club to, if elected or accepted into Membership, to conform to those Rules and Regulations and to accept, abide by and implement the decisions of the Management Committee of the Competition, subject to the right of appeal in accordance with Rule 16.

Any alteration of the Chairman and /or Secretary on the above Agreement shall be notified to the County Football Association to which the Club is affiliated and to the Secretary of the Competition.

(Note: The spaces above are intended for the inclusion of the signatures and addresses of officers and members).

Qualification of Players

(Note: Only players who reach the age of 16 years by 31st August will be registered to play in the coming season).

8. (A) Contract players, as defined in Football Association Rules, are not permitted in this Competition.

(B) A registered playing member of a Club is one who, being in all other respects eligible, has:-

Signed a fully and correctly completed Competition Registration Form in ink, with photograph attached, counterfoil signed by an Officer of the Club together with a Stamped Addressed Envelope, and who has been registered with the Registration Secretary seven (7) days prior to playing and whose completed counterfoil has been received by the Club prior to playing. Failure to forward a Stamped Addressed Envelope shall incur a fine not exceeding £10.00

(C)

(i) Each Club shall be responsible for retaining their players registration documents which shall be shown to their opponents for inspection prior to the start of the game. A member of the Management Committee may inspect registration documents at any time before, during, or after the game. For any player who does not have a registration document, if challenged, shall sign an exemption form as provided by the Management Committee.

Any Club failing to produce all players registration documents, when requested without reasonable explanation, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £30.00.

(ii) Any Club who allows a player who has not been registered with this Competition, or allows a player whilst under suspension, to play in any match within these Competitions, shall be fined a sum not exceeding £150.00. The points for any such match shall be awarded to the non-offending Club. If a match is a Cup-Tie, then the Cup-Tie shall be awarded to the non-offending Club.

(D) If a Club has a First Team and a Reserve Team playing in this Competition and a player has played more than five (5) matches before 1st December for the First Team (the Team playing in a higher Division than the other), then that player becomes a "restricted player" and a Club cannot play more than three (3) such "restricted players" in that Club's Reserve Team, at any one time, except by permission of the Management Committee. Any Club who is found guilty of breaking the Rule shall be fined a sum not exceeding £20.00 and the points for any such match or Cup-Tie shall be awarded to the non-offending Club.

(E) A player having taken part in matches for any Club affiliated to any County Football Association shall not be allowed to join, be transferred to, or sign for a Club in the Competition without first proving to the officials of the intended Club that the player has discharged all reasonable financial liabilities to the previous Club or Clubs, and a Club official may not accept such player's signature without first ascertaining whether such claims have been discharged to the satisfaction of the Club, or Clubs, for which the player last played.

(F) All member Clubs shall pay for an initial supply of twenty (20) Registration Forms (per Team).

All Clubs shall be invoiced for twenty (20) Registration Forms (per Team) at the start of the season.

All clubs must register a TEAM at least fourteen (14) days before the commencement of the season. Any registration received after this date will not be eligible to play in the first game.

All Clubs shall be invoiced in March, after the registration deadline (Rule 8(L)), at £3.00 per registration based on the number of registrations in excess of the initial twenty (20) made by each Club during the season.

Any Club with less than twenty (20) registrations (per Team) shall be reimbursed accordingly.

G) The Management Committee shall decide all registration disputes.

In the event of a player signing a registration form or having a registration submitted for more than one Club, priority of registration shall decide for which Club the player shall be registered. The Registration Secretary shall notify the Club last applying to register the player of the fact of the previous registration.

(H) It shall be deemed misconduct for a player to:-

Play for more than one Club in the Competition in the same season without first being transferred.

- (i) Having signed for one Club in the Competition, sign for another Club in the Competition in that season except for the purpose of a transfer.
- (ii) Submit a signed registration form for registration that the player had wilfully neglected to accurately or fully complete.

(J)

- (i) The Management Committee shall have power to accept the registration of any player. The Management Committee shall have power to refuse, cancel or suspend the registration of any player or may fine any player at their discretion proved guilty of registration irregularities. (Subject to Rule 16).
- (ii) The Management Committee shall have power to refuse or cancel the registration of any player found guilty of undesirable conduct and to disqualify the player in question from participating in all games in the Competition. (Subject to Rule 16).

(Note: Action under Clause (2) shall not be taken against a player for misconduct on the field of play until the matter has been dealt with by the appropriate Association, and then only in cases of the player bringing the Competition into disrepute.)

(K) Subject to The Football Association Rules dealing with players without a written contract when a player desires a transfer, the Club the player wishes to transfer to shall submit a transfer form to the Registration Secretary together with a Stamped Addressed Envelope. Failure to comply shall incur a fine of £10.00. Such transfer shall be referred by the Registration Secretary to the Club for which the player is registered. Should this Club object to the transfer it should state its objections in writing to the Registration Secretary and to the player concerned within seven (7) days of receipt of the transfer form. Upon receipt of the Club's consent, or upon its failure to give written objection within seven days, the Registration Secretary may, on behalf of the Management Committee, transfer the player who shall be deemed eligible to play for the new Club from such date or 48 hours after receipt of such transfer.

In the event of an objection to a transfer the matter shall be referred to the Management Committee for a decision.

(L) A player may not be registered for a Club nor transferred to another Club in the Competition after 28th February except by special permission of the Management Committee. The latest date for registrations or transfers to be eligible for Cup Competitions is 31st January.

(M) A Club shall keep a list of the players it registers and a record of the games in which they have played, and shall produce such records upon demand by the Management Committee.

(N) A register containing the names of all players registered for each Club, with the date of registration, shall be kept by the Registration Secretary and shall be open to the inspection of any duly appointed Member Club representative at all Management Committee meetings or at other times mutually arranged. Registrations are valid for one season only.

(O) A player shall not be eligible to play for a Team in any special championship, promotion or relegation deciding match (as specified in Rule 12(A)) unless the player has played three (3) games for that Team in this Competition before 28th February.

(P)

(i) Any Team playing an unregistered or otherwise ineligible player or players shall have the points gained in the match deducted from its total and may be fined a sum not exceeding £150.00 and/or otherwise dealt with at the discretion of the Management Committee.

(i) In addition the Team shall have three (3) points deducted from its total at the discretion of the Management Committee and may be dealt with in any further manner, which is thought to be fit.

(iii) The Management Committee in exceptional circumstances may, at its discretion, award any points deducted from a Club under this Rule to the opponents in the match in question, subject to the match not being ordered to be replayed.

(Q) Priority shall be given at all times to school and school organisation activities.

(Note: For players under the age of 18 the provisions contained in Football Association Rules shall apply.)

Club Colours, Club Name

9. (A) Every Club shall register the colour of its shirts and shorts with the Secretary by 31st May who shall decide as to their suitability.

Goalkeepers shall wear colours, which distinguish them from other players and the referee.

No player, including the goalkeeper, shall be permitted to wear black or very dark shirts.

Any Team not being able to play in its normal colours as registered with the Competition shall notify the colours in which they shall play to its opponents at least two (2) days before the match.

If, in the opinion of the Referee, two Clubs have the same or similar colours, the Home Team shall make the change. Any Team not having a change of colours or delaying the kick-off by not having a change shall be fined a sum not exceeding £20.00.

The Secretary of the Competition may request shirts to be submitted if complaints are received as to lack of distinguishing colours, and the Management Committee may refuse to permit any shirts or shorts as they think fit. Shirts shall be uniquely numbered.

(B) Any Club wishing to change its name and/or colours shall obtain permission from its affiliated County Association and from the Management Committee.

Playing Season, Conditions of Play, Times of Kick-Off, Postponements, Substitutes

10. (A) The Annual General Meeting shall determine the commencing and concluding dates for the ensuing season, which shall be in accordance with Football Association Rules. No Club shall be compelled to play after the concluding date.

Original fixtures arranged by the Fixture Secretary, shall not be arranged for a date later than seven (7) days preceding the concluding date determined by the Annual General Meeting.

(B) All matches shall be played in accordance with the Laws of the Game as determined by the International Football Association Board.

Clubs shall take all reasonable precautions to keep their grounds in a playable condition. All matches shall be played on pitches deemed suitable by the Management Committee. If through any fault of the Home Team a match has to be replayed, the Management Committee shall have power to order the venue to be changed.

The Management Committee shall have power to decide whether a pitch and/or facilities are suitable for matches in the Competition and to order the Club concerned to play its fixtures on another ground.

All matches shall have a duration of 90 minutes unless a shorter time (not less than 70 minutes) is mutually arranged by the two Captains in consultation with the referee prior to the commencement of the match, and in any event shall be of equal halves.

The times of kick-off shall be fixed by the Annual General Meeting or the Management Committee. Any Club failing to commence at the appointed time shall be fined a sum not exceeding £30.00 or be otherwise dealt with as the Management Committee may determine.

Any Team failing to commence any match within fifteen (15) minutes of the appointed kick-off time, shall be considered as non-fulfilling that fixture, and dealt with according to Rule 10(f), except under exceptional circumstances.

Referees shall order matches to commence at the appointed time and shall report all late starts to the Competition.

The Home Team shall provide at least two (2) footballs fit for play and the referee shall make a report to the Competition if the footballs are unsuitable. Goal nets shall be used.

(C) Except by permission of the Management Committee all matches shall be played on the dates originally fixed but priority shall be given to The Football Association and all relevant County Association Cup Competitions. All other matches shall be considered secondary. Clubs may mutually agree to bring forward a match with the consent of the Fixture Secretary.

Once a fixture has appeared on the Fixture List, it shall only be postponed for reasons of bad weather as mentioned elsewhere in this Rule. Clubs wishing to have a "free Sunday" shall let the Fixture Secretary know, in writing, at least eight (8) weeks in advance. Any Club failing to fulfil such a fixture shall be fined under a sum not exceeding £150.00.

(D) The Secretary of the Home Club shall give notice of full particulars of the location of, and access to, the ground and time of kick-off to the match officials and the Secretary of the opposing Club at least three (3) clear days prior to the playing of the match. Any Club failing to comply with this Rule shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £20.00.

(E) Every Club shall play its best available qualified Team or Teams in all matches in the Competition.

(F) Home and away matches shall be played. In the event of a Club failing to keep its engagement the Management Committee shall have power to inflict a fine not exceeding £150.00, deduct points from the defaulting Club, award the points to the opponents, order the defaulting Club to pay any expenses incurred by the opponents or otherwise deal with them except the award of goals.

Insufficient registered players, illness, lack of transport or injuries to players shall not be accepted as satisfactory reasons for requesting postponements of matches. Any Club with more than one side in these Competitions shall always fulfil its fixtures in the following order of precedence: 1st Team, Reserves, and in descending order of seniority. Clubs in breach of this requirement shall be fined a sum not exceeding £150.00, and may be ordered to replay the match or matches under such conditions as the Management Committee may direct.

In instances where a groundsman of a local authority or of a school has absolute authority over the use of the ground, his decision shall be accepted as if it were made by Management Committee Member or a Registered Referee, but all other requirements concerning postponements shall be complied with in accordance with this Rule.

Should the fitness of the ground be in doubt, the Secretary or delegated Officer of the Home Club may seek the advice and opinion of any member of the Management Committee or Registered Referee not connected with the Club as listed in any current official Handbook, who may authorise postponement of the match if the conditions of the ground warrant a postponement.

A member of the Management Committee or Registered Referee called in by a Club shall be entitled to a fee of £10.00 and travelling expenses, of 40 pence/mile, this expense to be met by the Home Club, except in the case of a game on a neutral ground when the Competition shall meet the expense.

When a match is so postponed and at least three (3) hours notice is given to the Secretary of the Visiting Club and to the Referee, the Home Club shall not be liable to a penalty nor to pay expenses.

When a match is so postponed and less than three (3) hours notice, before the time of kick-off is given to the Secretary of the Visiting Club and/or the Referee, the Home Club may be ordered to pay expenses approved by the Management Committee, shall be adjudged to have been guilty of misconduct and shall be fined a sum not exceeding £50.00, but a fine may be waived if the Management Committee is satisfied that a Management Committee Member or Registered Referee called in to inspect the pitch was unable to give a decision allowing at least three (3) hours notice to be given and that after an authorised postponement as per the above paragraphs the Home Club took reasonable steps to prevent the appointed Referee and Opponents from travelling.

If a Club fails to seek advice from a member of the Management Committee, or a Registered Referee, in accordance with the Rule above, and the match is subsequently postponed by the Referee in charge of the fixture because of ground conditions, then the Home Club may also be adjudged to have been guilty of misconduct and may also be ordered to pay expenses approved by the Management Committee.

Notice of postponement of any match shall be given without delay by the postponing Club (or notice of a Club being unable to fulfil any match shall be given 48 hours prior to the match by the Club) to the Fixture Secretary on the official form, the Press Officer the Competition Referees Secretary, the Secretary of the opposing Club and the match officials. Any Club failing to comply shall be dealt with by the Management Committee who may inflict any penalty it may deem suitable.

A Club suspended by the Association to which it is affiliated, and so unable to fulfil a fixture or fixtures, in these Competitions, shall be liable to pay any expenses incurred by the Competitions as a result and shall be fined a sum not exceeding £50.00.

Also the suspended Club shall be liable to pay any expenses incurred by the non-offending Club where a game cannot be fulfilled.

In the event of a match not being played or abandoned owing to causes over which neither Club has control, it shall be played in its entirety on a date to be arranged by the Management Committee.

The Management Committee shall review all abandoned matches and in a case where it is to the advantage of the Competition and does no injustice to either Club, shall be empowered to order the score at the time of the abandonment to stand. In all cases where the Management Committee are satisfied that a match was abandoned owing to the conduct of one Team or its Club member(s) they shall be empowered to award the points for the match to the opponents and/or take what other action they may deem necessary. In cases where a match is abandoned owing to the conduct of both Teams or their Club members, the Management Committee shall take such action as they consider appropriate. Such action is subject to any disciplinary action taken by the appropriate Affiliated Association.

(G) A Club may at its discretion and in accordance with the Laws of the Game use three (3) substitute players in any match in this Competition who may be selected from five (5) players.

The referee shall be informed of the names of the substitutes not later than five (5) minutes before the start of the match.

A player who has been selected, appointed or named as a substitute before the start of the match but does not actually play in the game shall not be considered to have been a player in that game within the meaning of Rule 8 of this Competition.

(H) The half time interval shall be of five (5) minutes duration, but it shall not exceed fifteen (15) minutes. The half time interval may only be altered with the consent of the referee.

Reporting Results

11. (A) The Registration Secretary shall receive within four (4) days of the date played, the result of each Competition match in the prescribed manner. This shall include the forename(s) and surname of the Team players (in block letters) and also the Referee markings required by Rule 13, or any other information required by the Competition. Failure to do so shall incur a fine not exceeding £20.00 and/or the Club being dealt with as the Management Committee decides.

The date of postmark shall be sole proof of despatch of such cards.

(B) The Home Club shall telephone the result of each match to the Press Officer by 5-00pm for Sunday matches and by 9-30pm for Evening matches. Also the result of any matches outside this Competition of which they have participated in, whether Home or Away. This telephone result shall be given before 5-00pm on the day of the match, unless it is an evening match, then the result shall be telephoned in before 9-30pm. Failure to comply shall incur a fine not exceeding £20.00.

(C) The match result notification, correctly completed, shall be signed by a responsible member of the Club. The Management Committee shall have power to take such action as they deem suitable against a Club, which submits an incomplete form or incorrect information.

(D) Clubs marking a Referee with thirty (30) marks or less shall, within seven (7) days of submitting the card, send to the Referee Secretary a written explanation for the mark given, a Club failing to comply shall be fined a sum not exceeding £20.00.

Determining Championship

12. (A) Team rankings within the Competition shall be decided by points with three (3) points to be awarded for a win and one (1) points for a drawn match. The Teams gaining the highest number of points in their respective Divisions at the conclusion shall be adjudged the winners. Matches shall not be played for double points.

In the event of two or more Teams being equal on points for first place, Team rankings shall be decided in the following way:-

- (i) deciding match(es) played under conditions determined by the Management Committee.

(B)

- (i) The three leading Clubs in Division Two plus the leading two Clubs in Divisions 3A and 3B shall be promoted to a higher Division, unless prevented because paragraph (iii) of this Rule is applicable.

- (ii) The three lowest Clubs in Division One plus the lowest four Club in Division Two shall be liable for relegation to a lower Division, unless for any other reason relegation shall not take place.

- (iii) No Club shall have more than one Team in any Division.

- (iv) Except for that provided for in 12(A) above, final placing in the League and issues of promotion and relegation shall be decided, when Teams finish the season with equal numbers of points, on the basis of goal difference. Goals against shall be deducted from goals for and the Team or Teams with the highest positive or lowest negative goal difference shall be given precedence in the League positions. Where goal difference is equal, the Team scoring the most goals shall be judged to finish higher. If Teams are still equal and promote/relegation depends upon positions, then the Management Committee shall make arrangements for play-off match or matches.

(C) A Club withdrawing, having played 75% of League matches shall retain its record, but the points shall be awarded to the opponents of outstanding matches. In the event of a Team not completing 75% of its fixtures for the season all points obtained by or recorded against such defaulting Team shall be expunged from the Competition table.

Referees

13. (A) Registered Referees and Assistant Referees for all matches shall be appointed in a manner approved by the Management Committee and by the sanctioning Association(s).

(B) In the event of the non-appearance of the appointed Referee the appointed senior Assistant Referee shall take charge and a substitute Assistant Referee appointed by the competing Teams. In cases where there are no officially appointed Assistant Referees, the Clubs shall agree upon a Referee. A Referee thus agreed upon shall, for that game, have the full powers, status and authority of a registered Referee.

In the event of the late arrival of the appointed Referee, the substitute Referee shall take charge until the arrival of the former, provided this takes place before the commencement of the second half of the game. A Referee who is late in arriving shall continue and not restart the game if and when he takes over. In such cases, the appointed Referee is entitled to the fee and expenses.

(C) The Management Committee may, if they consider it desirable, or upon application by the two competing Clubs, appoint Assistant Referees, if available, to any match. Where Assistant Referees are not appointed each Team shall provide a Club Assistant Referee. Failure to do so shall result in a fine of not exceeding £20.00 being imposed on the defaulting Team.

(D) The appointed Referee shall have power to decide as to the fitness of the ground in all matches and the decision shall be final subject to either in the case of a ground of a Local Authority or the owners of a ground, the Representative of that body is the sole arbiter and whose decision shall be accepted unless the ground is declared fit for play.

(E) Match Officials appointed under this Rule shall be entitled to the following match fees, which are inclusive of expenses. Referees £30.00, registered Referees appointed by the Competition as Assistant Referees £25.00, subject to any limits laid down by the sanctioning Association, except in Cup Finals when a suitable memento shall be awarded.

The Home Club shall pay the Officials their fees before commencement of the match. Failure to comply shall result in a fine not exceeding £30.00. The fees are shared by both Clubs and it is the responsibility of the Home Club to collect the Away Clubs contribution to the fees.

(F) In the event of a match not being played because of circumstances over which the Clubs have no control, the Match Officials, if present, shall be entitled to half fee. For matches when three (3) Officials are appointed then the Competition shall pay 50% of the fee and the two Clubs 25% each. Where a match is not played owing to one Club being in default, that Club shall be ordered to pay the Officials, if they attend the ground, their full fee.

(G) A Referee not keeping his engagement, and failing to give a satisfactory explanation as to his non-appearance, may have his name removed from the list of Referees and the fact reported to the Association with which he is registered.

(H) Each Club shall, in a manner prescribed from time to time by The Football Association, award marks to the Referee for each match and the name of the Referee and the marks awarded shall be submitted to the Competition on the prescribed Form provided. Clubs failing to comply with this Rule shall be liable to be fined or dealt with as the Management Committee shall determine.

The Competition shall keep a record of the markings and, on the Form provided by the prescribed date each season, shall submit a summary to The Football Association/County Association.

(J) The Referee shall submit a report Form, supplied by the Competition, giving the result of the match, the number of players in each Team and the time of kick-off to the Referee Secretary within five (5) days of the match.

(K) Referees and Assistant Referees shall be supplied, each Season, with a copy of the Competition Rules free of charge.

Continuation of Membership or Withdrawal of a Club

14. (A) After 31st December in the current Season a Club intending, or having a provisional intention, to withdraw a Team from the Competition on completion of its fixtures and fulfilment of all other obligations to the Competition shall notify the Secretary in writing by 31st March each Season or be liable to a fine not exceeding £150.00.

(B) A Club shall not be allowed to withdraw any or all of its Teams from the Competition after the Annual General Meeting for the following Season. Any Club infringing this Rule shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £150.00 per Team and shall also be liable for its share of any call which may be made under Rule 5(B).

(C) The Membership for the coming season having been decided at a Special General Meeting held for that purpose at the Annual General Meeting held not later than 30th June the Competition shall have the right, irrespective of other provisions in this Rule, to refuse to permit a Club to withdraw its Team(s) in order to join another Competition and may hold the Club to its engagements

(D) In the event of a Member Club which is an un-incorporated association withdrawing and/or disbanding it shall be immediately liable to discharge all its financial and other obligations to the Competition.

In the event that any such obligation remains undischarged after a period of twenty-one (21) days then such obligation shall be met by the then current Club Members, excluding those under the statutory school leaving age. Until a Member's pro rata obligation is discharged in full the Member shall not be allowed to participate in the Competition, which may apply to the Club's Parent County Association for a suspension order.

Protests and Appeals

15. (A)

(i) All questions of eligibility, qualifications of players or interpretations of the Rules shall be referred to the Management Committee.

(ii) Objections relevant to the dimensions of the pitch, goals, flag posts or other facilities of the venue shall not be entertained by the Management Committee unless a protest is lodged with the Referee before the commencement of the match. Any Club lodging such protest and not proceeding with it shall be deemed guilty of a breach of this Rule and shall be dealt with by the Management Committee.

(B) Except in cases where the Management Committee decide that there are special circumstances, protests and complaints (which shall contain full particulars of the grounds upon which they are founded) shall be lodged in duplicate with the Secretary within three (3) days (excluding Sundays) of the match or occurrence to

which they refer. A protest or complaint shall not be withdrawn except by permission of the Management Committee. A Member of the Management Committee who is a member of any Club involved shall not be present (except as a witness or representative of his Club) when such protest or complaint is being determined.

(C) Any dispute occurring between Clubs in the Competition shall be referred for determination by the Management Committee whose decision shall be binding upon all parties subject to Rule 16.

(D) No protest of whatever kind shall be considered by the Management Committee unless the complaining Club shall have deposited with the Secretary a sum of £10.00. This may be forfeited in whole or in part in the event of the complaining or protesting Club losing its case. The Competition shall have power to order the defaulting Club or the Club making a losing or frivolous protest or complaint to pay the expenses of the enquiry or to order that the costs to be shared by the parties.

(E) All parties to a protest or complaint shall be afforded an opportunity to make a statement when the protest or complaint is being heard and shall have received seven (7) days notice of the hearing, together with a copy of the submission. When dealing with a protest or complaint the Management Committee shall take into consideration the possession by the protesting or complaining Club of any information which, if properly used, might have avoided the protest or complaint.

Board of Appeal

16. Within fourteen (14) days of the posting of written notification of any decision of the Management Committee or the Competition a Club, Official or Player against whom action is taken may appeal against such decision by lodging particulars in duplicate with the Secretary of the respective County Football Association, including a fee of £25.00, for adjudication of a Board of Appeal. The grounds of appeal shall be in accordance with FA Rules. The Board of Appeal may order the appeal fee to be forfeited and shall decide by whom the costs of the appeal shall be borne. The decision of the Board of Appeal is final and binding on all parties concerned.

A copy of any Appeal shall be forwarded to the General Secretary at the same time.

Exclusion of Clubs, or Teams Misconduct, Clubs, Officials, Players

17. (A) At the Annual General Meeting, or Special General Meeting called for the purpose, Notice of Motion having been duly circulated on the Agenda, the accredited delegates present shall have the power to exclude any Club or Team from further membership upon a majority of two-thirds of the votes cast. Voting on this point shall be conducted by ballot.

(B) At the Annual General Meeting, or at a Special General Meeting called for the purpose, in accordance with the provisions of Rule 19, the accredited delegates present shall have the power to exclude from further participation in the Competition any Club or Team whose conduct has, in their opinion, been undesirable upon a majority of two-thirds of the votes cast. Voting on this point shall be conducted by ballot. A Club whose conduct is the subject of the vote being taken shall be excluded from voting.

(C) Any official or member of a Club proved guilty of either misconduct, other than field offences, or of inducing or attempting to induce a player or players of another Club in the Competition to join them shall be liable to expulsion or such penalty as a General Meeting or Management Committee may decide, and their Club shall also be liable to expulsion in accordance with the provisions of Clauses (A) and (B) of this Rule.

(D) Any Club or Team failing to complete 75% of its fixtures in any season shall (unless the conditions are beyond their control, or the accredited delegates present at the Annual General Meeting or a Special General Meeting decide otherwise by a majority of two-thirds of the votes cast) be excluded from membership the following season.

Trophy:- Legal Owners, Conditions of Taking Over, Agreement to be Signed, Awards

18. (A) A Competition Cup or Trophy shall be vested in the Association sanctioning the Competition as Trustees. If a Competition were discontinued for any cause the Cup or Trophy shall be returned to the Donor, if the conditions attached to it so provide, or otherwise dealt with as the Association may decide. At the close of each Competition awards shall be made to the winners and runners-up if the funds of the Competition permit.

The following agreement shall be signed on behalf of the winners of the Cup or Trophy:-

“We A _____ and B _____, the Chairman and Secretary of _____ FC, members of and representing the Club, having been declared winners of Upper Thames Valley League Cup or Trophy, and it having been delivered to us by the Competition, do hereby on behalf of the Club jointly and severally agree to return the Cup or Trophy to the Competition Secretary on or before 1st March. Failure to comply shall incur a fine not exceeding £30.00. If the Cup or Trophy is lost or damaged whilst under our care we agree to refund to the Competition the amount of its current value or the cost of its thorough repair.”

(B) The Trophies shall be insured by the Competitions, but the Club winning a trophy shall pay the Competition the cost of the premium. This shall be payable on demand to the Treasurer.

Special General Meetings

19. Upon receiving a requisition signed by two-thirds of the Clubs in membership the Secretary shall call a Special General Meeting.

The Management Committee may call a Special General Meeting at any time.

At least fourteen (14) days notice shall be given of either meeting under this Rule, together with an agenda of the business to be transacted at such meeting.

Each Full Member Club shall be empowered to send two (2) delegates to all Special General Meetings. Each Club shall be entitled to one (1) vote only. Not less than fourteen (14) days' notice shall be given of any Meeting.

Any continuing Member Club failing to be represented at a Special General Meeting without satisfactory reason being given shall be fined a sum not exceeding £30.00. Officers and Management Committee members shall be entitled to attend and vote at all Special General Meetings.

Alteration to Rules

20. Alterations shall be made to these Rules only at the Annual General Meeting or at a Special General Meeting specially convened for the purpose called in accordance with Rule 19. Any alteration made during the playing season to the Rule relating to the qualification of players shall not take effect until the following season.

Notice of proposed alterations to be considered at the Annual General Meeting shall be submitted to the Secretary by 28th February in each year. The proposals, together with any proposals by the Management Committee, shall be circulated to the Clubs by 15th March and any amendments thereto shall be submitted to the Secretary by 31st March. The proposals and proposed amendments thereto shall be circulated to Clubs with the notice of the Annual General Meeting. A proposal to change a Rule shall be carried if two-thirds of those present and entitled to vote are in favour.

A copy of the proposed alterations to Rules to be considered at the Annual General Meeting or Special General Meeting shall be submitted to the sanctioning Football Association by 14th April each year.

Any alterations or additions decided upon at any meeting shall not become operative until the approval of the Association issuing sanction shall have been obtained.

Rules Binding on Clubs

21. Each Member Club shall be deemed to have given its assent to the foregoing Rules and agreed to abide by the decisions of the Management Committee subject to Rule 16. Each Member Club shall abide by any issued Football Association Code of Conduct.

Every Club competing in these Competitions shall receive one Rule Book. If a Club requests the need for more than one copy, then that Club shall pay to the Treasurer the cost of each copy that the Club requests.

Finance

22. (A) The Management Committee shall determine with which bank or other financial institution the funds of the Competition shall be lodged.

(B) All expenditure in excess of £100.00 shall be approved by the Management Committee. Cheques shall be signed by at least two Officers nominated by the Management Committee.

(C) The financial year of the Competition shall end on 31st March

(D) The books, or a certified Balance Sheet, of a Competition shall be prepared and shall be audited annually by some suitable person(s) who shall be appointed at the Annual General Meeting.

The Devenney Cup

1. **The Officers of the Competitions:** shall for all intents and purposes, be responsible for the management of this Competition.
2. **Only Clubs:** who are members of the Competition shall compete in this Competition.
3. **Fees:** Entrance Fee shall be £10.00 per Team.
4. **The Rules:** of the Competition shall apply.
5. **The Draw:** The pairing of all rounds shall be decided by a draw. The first Club so drawn shall have the choice of ground. Should a result not be forthcoming after 90 minutes, extra time shall be played of fifteen (15) minutes each half. If after this, the scores are still level, the winner shall be decided by the taking of kicks from the penalty mark in accordance with International Board Procedures.

The semi-finals shall be played on the ground of the first team drawn. The final shall be played on a neutral ground to be decided by the Management Committee, with extra time of fifteen (15) each half being played where necessary. If after extra time has been played and the result is still inconclusive, the winner shall be decided by the taking of kicks from the penalty mark in accordance with International Board Procedures.

6. **Medals:** The Committee shall decide upon the awards to the two Teams and their substitutes competing in the Final.
7. **Qualification of Players:** Every player shall sign the form supplied by the Management Committee. No player shall register for more than one Club per season. A player who is transferring from one Club to another and has already played in the Devenney Cup for the Club is transferring from, shall not be eligible to play for his new Club in the Cup Competition for the rest of the season. No player shall register for any Club after 31st January of that particular season. Except by permission of the Management Committee, no player may compete in the semi-finals or Final unless he has played for the Club concerned in three (3) matches, under the jurisdiction of the Competition prior to the last day of February in the current season. Clubs shall be notified by the League Registration Secretary when a player transfers, of eligibility to play in the Devenney Cup Competition. Any Club breaking said Rule shall be excluded from the Competition and fined a sum not exceeding £10.00.

The Ridgeway Challenge Cup

1. **The Officers of the Competitions:** shall for all intents and purposes, be responsible for the management of this Competition.
2. **Only Clubs:** who are members of the Competition shall compete in this Competition.
3. **Fees:** Entrance Fee shall be £10.00 per Team.
4. **The Rules:** of the Competition shall apply.
5. **Eligibility:** for the Ridgeway Challenge Cup shall be extended to all Clubs having Teams outside the First Division of the Competition. In the event of a Club having both First and Reserve Teams outside the First Division, then entry shall be open to that Club's Reserve Team only.
6. **The Draw:** The pairing of all rounds shall be decided by a draw. The first Club so drawn shall have the choice of ground. Should a result not be forthcoming after 90 minutes, extra time shall be played of fifteen (15) minutes each half. If after this, the scores are still level, the winner shall be decided by the taking of kicks from the penalty mark in accordance with International Board Procedures.

The semi-finals shall be played on the ground of the first team drawn. The Final shall be played on a neutral ground to be decided by the Management Committee, with extra time of fifteen (15) each half being played where necessary. If after extra time has been played and the result is still inconclusive, the winner shall be decided by the taking of kicks from the penalty mark in accordance with International Board Procedures.

7. **Medals:** The Committee shall decide upon the awards to the two Teams and their substitutes competing in the Final.
8. **Qualification of Players:** Every player shall sign the form supplied by the Management Committee. No player shall register for more than one Club per season. A player who is transferring from one Club to another and has already played in the Ridgeway Challenge Cup for the Club is transferring from, shall not be eligible to play for his new Club in the Cup Competition for the rest of the season. No player shall register for any Club after 31st January of that particular season. Except by permission of the Management Committee, no player may compete in the semi-finals or Final unless he has played for the Club concerned in three (3) matches under the jurisdiction of the Competition prior to the last day of February in the current season. Clubs shall be notified by the League Registration Secretary when a player transfers, of eligibility to play in the Ridgeway Challenge Cup Competition. Any Club breaking said Rule shall be excluded from the Competition and fined a sum not exceeding £10.00.

The Hedley Toms/Michael Brown Memorial Trophy

Teams from the Premier Division and Division One will compete for this trophy. All other Cup Rules shall apply.

The Alan Alder Memorial Invitation Trophy

1. This Cup Competition shall take place annually if fixture backlog from all other Competitions is not delayed and shall involve those Clubs who have played sufficient fixtures to warrant an invitation.
2. A Sub-Committee shall meet to decide on Clubs to be invited and invitations to those Clubs shall be sent out after the first Sunday in January.
3. The minimum number of entrants to be invited in any one season shall be four sides and the maximum number of entrants shall be sixteen sides. Entry fee to be £10.00 per Club.
4. If more than four Clubs are invited, then the First Round of the Competition shall be played on a group basis and the draw for these groups shall be presented to full Committee for approval, involving only those Clubs who have accepted their invitation in writing and have paid the entry fee.
5. semi-finals and a Final shall take place after the group games, all venues to be decided by the Management Committee. semi-finals and Final to be decided by taking of kicks from the penalty mark in accordance with International Board Procedures, if extra time produces no outcome.
6. Specific invitations shall be sent to a First or Reserve Team where a Club has both playing in these Competitions and Qualification of Players (Rule 6) of the Devenney Cup shall apply.
7. Teams may be seeded in groups at the discretion of the Sub-Committee.
8. All other Rules of the Devenney Cup shall apply.

Small-Sided Tournament

1. Only Clubs who are members of the Competition shall be invited to compete in this Competition.
2. The Management Committee shall decide whether this Tournament shall be annual.
3. Entrance Fee shall be £20.00 per Team.
4. A list of eight (8) nominated players shall be handed to the Secretary of the Competition, at least ten (10) minutes prior to a Team's first game.
5. A player shall be a bona-fide member of his Club, and shall have signed Registration Forms for that Club, to be able to compete for that Club.
6. The first Team drawn in each game shall be responsible for providing a match ball.
7. The Management Committee shall decide annually whether this Tournament shall be played with 5-a-Side or 6-a-Side.
8. A maximum of two (2) substitutes (from the list of eight (8) nominated players) may be named to the Referee before the kick-off of each game, but only one substitute shall be allowed during a game.
9. Trophies shall be awarded to the winners and runners-up of the Competition.
10. The Competition shall be decided on a group system. Teams shall be drawn into groups playing each other once with the winners and runners-up of each group going forward to compete on a knock-out basis.

In the group system points shall be awarded, three (3) points win, one (1) point draw, nil (0) points lose. In the event of the league placings being tied (i.e. equal number of points) goal difference shall count. If they are still level then the team scoring the most goals is the winner. If teams are still level a play-off shall take place to decide league placings.

11. The Management Committee shall decide how many minutes each half shall consist of, but each half shall be of equal duration. The Management Committee shall notify each Club of its decision on this Rule before the start of the Tournament.
12. Any player sent from the Field of Play shall take no further part in the Competition. However, a side may in subsequent rounds use a player nominated for that side before the start of the Tournament, to make up the side.
13. Registered Referees shall be appointed for all matches and their decisions on all points of play shall be final.
14. Any disputed point (other than points of play) shall be decided by the Appeals Committee, whose decision shall be final. Any appeal shall be lodged within ten (10) minutes of the conclusion of the game in question, along with a deposit of £5.00.
15. In the event of opposing Teams having the same colours the first named Team shall change.
16. In any point not covered by these Rules, the decision of the Appeals Committee shall be final.
17. There shall be no offside.
